

Toyota is known for creating dependable cars that last for many years and miles—and that extends to the Corolla. With lots of features and a great safety track record, this vehicle is a great choice for drivers of various ages and lifestyles.

A Sporty Exterior Design

The 2019 Toyota Corolla may be smaller than other vehicles on the road, but it offers a commanding appearance that shows other cars who's boss.

The vehicle has a sleek shape, with two grille options acting as the focal point: standard bold front fascia with a Piano Black grille or available sport front fascia with a Gloss Black, mesh-pattern grille. Bi-LED headlights come standard and look stylish, no matter the time of day. Plus, available Multi-LED headlights with integrated LED accent lights will help you see and be seen even better at night.

You'll then get 15-inch styled steel wheels in the base trim, while some of the higher trim levels offer 17-inch machined-alloy wheels with Black painted accents.

To cap off the car's look, there's an available spoiler in the back. This rear spoiler integrates seamlessly into the bold lines of the rear deck lid for an athletic look and feel to the vehicle.



A Stylish Interior Design

We'll then move inside the 2019 Corolla, where you'll find plenty of attractive design elements, which includes a fluid dashboard with flowing lines and available contrast stitching. Piano Black accents surround the display screen, while an available metallic interior trim really ties the cabin together.

Fabric-trimmed seating comes standard, while SofTex® upholstery is available. The latter is a synthetic leather that's easier to clean and more resistant to wear than traditional leather. So, even if you're in the car a lot, you can rest assured that the seats will look good for a long time.



Passenger & Cargo Room

Even though the Toyota Corolla is a compact car, it still offers plenty of room for five people. In fact, the interior gives you the following passenger dimensions...

- **Front headroom/legroom:** 38.3 inches/42.3 inches
- **Rear headroom/legroom:** 37.1 inches/41.4 inches
- **Passenger volume:** 97.5 cubic feet


The Corolla has a spacious cargo area, too, which is great for grocery bags, luggage, and other essential items. The trunk offers 13 cubic feet of space. However, if you need a bit of an extension, you can simply fold down one side of the 60/40 split rear seats. It lets you fit items while still leaving room for a backseat passenger. If you're riding solo, then fold down both sides to maximize cargo room.

Amenities in the 2019 Corolla

Not only does the inside of the Corolla offer plenty of style and space, but it has many creature comforts, too.

There are the optional heated front seats, for example. If it's especially chilly out, simply push the button and get cozy in a matter of seconds. Plus, there's an available 8-way power-adjustable driver's seat and 4-way adjustable front-passenger seat. Through this optional feature, you can quickly and easily get into your ideal sitting position.

If you like having the cabin set at a certain temperature, then utilize the available automatic climate control system. With the digital controls, you can select the temperature you want, and the cabin will always feel just right.



Cutting-Edge Infotainment Technology

If you're a big fan of technology, then you can appreciate the features found inside the 2019 Toyota Corolla.

The vehicle comes standard with an Entune™ Audio infotainment system that houses all your media options. Whether you utilize the radio, CD player, or Siri® Eyes Free, everything will appear on the 6.1-inch touchscreen and be heard clearly through the 6-speaker sound system. Plus, standard Bluetooth® technology will let you stream audio or make phone calls while keeping your hands on the steering wheel and your eyes on the road ahead.

Upgrade to a higher trim level, and you'll get the Entune™ Audio Plus system. The screen is now a 7-inch high-resolution touchscreen, and you get a 3-month All Access trial to SiriusXM® Satellite Radio. The latter feature gives you over 150 music, news, comedy, and sports stations to listen to for all-day entertainment.

Finally, there's the available Entune™ Premium Audio system with Integrated Navigation and an Entune® App Suite. The app suite lets you download various apps onto your mobile device, including Yelp® and OpenTable®. Then, plug the phone into the vehicle's USB port to have those apps appear on the display screen. In the end, you could find a new restaurant, make a dinner reservation, and get to your destination—all through the Corolla.



Advanced Safety Options



When you're driving around in any vehicle, it helps to know that there are safety features in place to protect you and your loved ones.

As for the Toyota Corolla, you'll find the Star Safety System™. This standard suite of active safety features is designed to provide optimum traction, braking, and more. The following features can help you avoid getting into an accident:

- Vehicle Stability Control
- Anti-lock Brake System
- Electronic Brake-force Distribution

However, if you were to get into an accident, you can have the peace of mind knowing that the Corolla has your back. After all, it comes standard with an Advanced Airbag System. From front and rear side curtain airbags to a driver knee airbag, you'll be well-protected inside this automobile.

Toyota Safety Sense™ P

However, there are even more safety features that can help prevent a collision from occurring. The Corolla comes standard with Toyota Safety Sense™ P (TSS-P), which is an intelligent suite of various driver-assisting technologies. They act as a second pair of eyes, alerting you to anything you might miss while driving.

Some of the features that you'll find in TSS-P are...

Pre-Collision System with Pedestrian Detection

This system uses an in-vehicle camera and radar to detect a person or vehicle in front of you. If you're getting too close to an object or individual, the system will send visual and audible warnings to hit the brakes. If you don't in time, it can apply them for you to help avoid a frontal collision.

Automatic High Beams

This feature helps you see better at night without blinding other drivers. If it's extremely dark out, the system will automatically turn the high beams on. Once the headlights of oncoming cars or taillights of preceding ones are detected, the system will automatically switch to low beams.

Dynamic Radar Cruise Control

This system uses vehicle-to-vehicle distance control. Not only can you adjust the speed, but you can also choose a specific distance to keep from the car in front of you. When that vehicle slows down, this cruise control feature will automatically slow your Corolla down to maintain that preset distance.



A Comfortable & Fuel-Efficient Ride

While all the above features are great to have in a car, you still want one that's reliable and fun to drive. Luckily, the 2019 Corolla has these characteristics, with smooth and responsive handling along with great fuel economy ratings.

It comes with a 1.8L 4-cylinder engine with Dual Variable Valve Timing with intelligence. It's mated to a continuously variable transmission for smooth shifting, and the engine itself delivers 132 horsepower and 128 lb-ft of torque. With this engine, you get an EPA-estimated fuel economy rating of 28 city/36 highway MPG.¹ While that's impressive, the Corolla LE Eco trim lets you drive even farther for longer.

This trim level is equipped with a 1.8L 4-cylinder that has Valvematic technology, producing 140 horsepower and 126 lb-ft of torque. It then achieves an EPA-estimated 30 city/40 highway MPG, so you can spend more time on the open road before needing to stop and refuel.²




Various Driving Modes

Then, there are the different driving modes available that can tailor your overall driving experience. For instance, Sport Mode will adjust the Engine Control Unit and simulated shift points to give you a more athletic ride.

Another mode that you could utilize is ECO Mode, which will ease the gas pedal output and adjust the air conditioning system to increase fuel efficiency. As a result, you'll be able to drive around town for even longer before needing to visit a gas station.
