
## **Lexus Personalized Settings**

It is also possible to customize certain vehicle features yourself using the navigation system screen.




## Vehicles with Navigation System:



STEP 1 Press the MENU button.



STEP 2 Highlight "Setup" using the Remote Touch unit and push knob to select.



STEP 3 Scroll to page 2. Highlight "Vehicle" and push knob to select.
